Caseload Counts: Number of children in the CBS caseload during the month.

Caseload per 10,000 Child Population: Ratio of the number of children in the caseload during the month per 10,000 children in the child population of the CMHC catchment area.

Living in a Family Home: Percent of children in the CBS caseload who were living in a family home at the end of the month. *Family Home* is defined as permanent home, independent living, foster home, therapeutic foster care, or temporarily living with a relative or family friend.

No Arrest or Law Enforcement Contact: Percent of children recorded as having either been arrested or as having parents contacted by law enforcement during the month.

Clinically Significant CBCL Score: Percent of all children who had at least one clinically significant CBCL Score.

A, B, or C Grades: Percent of children attending school each month who had A, B, or C grades recorded during the month.

Regular School Attendance: Percent of children attending school each month who had two or fewer unexcused absences during that month.

Missing Child Records: Number of children with a Chronicity = 6 (SED Receiving TCM or SPST) anytime during the month for whom no monthly record was submitted.
